ChatPower 24 & 42 were introduced for both NOVA chat 7 & 10 while ChatPower 80 is exclusively for NOVA chat 10. This past year we also introduced MultiChat Adult. There are multiple forms of communication available in this program; sentences, phrases, individual words, recordings for story-telling and visual scenes.

NOVA chat 10 has the largest display of any Chat communication device. It offers the well known Chat software on an Android platform. Like all "Chats," NOVA chat 10 offers a durable yet sleek portable design, with features that include a 10.1" display, switch scanning, Social Chat, new IVONA speech synthesizer, and many other Chat features.

NOVA chat 10 includes thousands of SymbolStix™ symbols, PCS™ symbols are available as an option. ChatPower 24, 42, and 80 as well as MultChat 15 are a couple of the vocabulary programs included in NOVA chat 10.

Chat Software

Chat software is a feature-rich application that provides the power behind the Chat products. This software contains the functionality and flexibility to meet the unique communication needs of individuals with varying needs and preferences. The included vocabulary files are an excellent starting point for many children and adults who need a portable communication device.

Pages

Like many dynamic screen communication devices, Chat software allows pages to be linked together to form a communication environment. Pages may be organized by activities, as you will find in the myQuickChat vocabularies, or organized in a way that leads you seamlessly through the construction of a sentence, as in ChatPower.

You have the flexibility to modify each page to meet the visual, access and language needs of each individual. You can select the number of buttons per page, the appearance of each button and the action that occurs when a button is pressed.

Vocabulary Files

All Chat devices come with several vocabulary files. These page sets are often great launching pads for individuals just beginning to use their communication device. The various vocabulary files are designed to meet a broad variety of communication needs. See pages 8-10 for details.

Symbols and Images

Symbols are often used on buttons to represent words and sentences, particularly for individuals who have difficulty with reading. Chat software comes with pre-loaded symbols for personalizing pages. SymbolStix is the default symbol set that comes with the Chat software. PCS symbols are an optional alternative.

Sometimes it is better to use a photo on a button instead of a symbol. For example, you may want to use photos of your classmates or family members. NOVA chat's offer built in cameras while computer programming software allows you to use any photo or image that you have on your computer as a picture for a button. Chat software also gives you the opportunity to use a photograph as the background for a page. On these pages, you can create buttons or hotspots to allow a beginning communicator to choose vocabulary from the context of a visual scene.

Spelling and Word Prediction

All Chat products include a variety of keyboards for spelling. Typed words can be spoken by the internal voice synthesizer. All 'Plus' and 'Dedicated Plus' models also include word prediction and abbreviation expansion.

Speech

All Chat devices include both digitized and synthesized speech. Digitized speech is recorded by a sibling, friend, etc. Synthesized speech is computer generated 'text-to-speech.' For the specific speech options available with each device, see page 16.

Windows Editing Software

You can easily customize and add vocabulary directly on the Chat device and/or use the included Editor software, which allows editing and customizing on a Windows computer. The Editor also provides an easy means of importing photos and other graphics to be used as symbols on the Chat device.

Running other Applications

Since Chat products are built on computers, other software applications can run on these hardware platforms. Chat software allows applications to be launched from a communication page button. Note: This feature is prohibited in dedicated models by Federal and state funding regulations.

Scanning

In addition to touch screen access, NOVA chat has a full complement of visual and auditory scanning capabilities. The user interface allows easy adjustment of various timing aspects, scanning patterns and switch input options to best take advantage of each individual's unique capabilities.





Chat Vocabulary

Chat devices ship with a number of default vocabulary files, or page sets. The vocabulary and organization of each vocabulary file was designed to address specific communication needs. All vocabulary files are fully customizable and can be personalized for each individual. The descriptions on the next three pages highlight a few of the available vocabulary files. For specific vocabulary included with each device, see page 16.

ChatPower

ChatPower is a word-based vocabulary using 24, 42 or 80 buttons per page. ChatPower was developed by Nancy L. Inman, M.A.T., CCC-SLP specifically for the NOVA chat.

ChatPower uses high-frequency core words to facilitate quick and easy sentence generation. It also includes nouns and adjectives that are organized in logical categories. Grammatical word classes have been included. As a sentence is being built, you often find that the next word you want to say can be spoken with one or two button presses. A spelling/word prediction page is used to spell words that are not included in the vocabulary set.

Being a word-based vocabulary, ChatPower can be used by a wide age group. Nouns, adjectives and verbs can be added and customized to meet the particular needs of the individual. Literacy skills are necessary to use ChatPower, as picture support has only been provided for picture producing words.

ChatPower24

ChatPower24 is a word-based vocabulary that allows for easy intuitive communication. The program has been designed specifically for this portable and readily available platform. It is a generative language system that will be familiar to those using WordPower on other systems, and easy to learn for new users.

ChatPower24 with Phrases

ChatPower24 with Phrases is also a word-based vocabulary program, but phrases and sentences starters have been incorporated in order to make language generation easier for those that may have difficulty with a word-based program. Core language and category-based words are included in this program.

ChatPower42

ChatPower42 is a word-based vocabulary that allows for easy and intuitive communication. ChatPower42 is a generative language system that will be familiar to those using WordPower on other systems, and easy to learn for new users.



ChatPower42 Basic

ChatPower42 Basic is a simplified version of ChatPower42. This word-based system remains rich in core vocabulary, and it may be appropriate for beginning users or those that need a more basic vocabulary design. It is designed to make communication fast and easy.

ChatPower80

ChatPower80 created specifically for the NOVA chat 10 combines spelling and word prediction with core vocabulary all at once.

AACcelerate with myVoice

AACcelerate with myVoice is a unique suite of AAC vocabulary sets for the Chat family targeting the communication needs of a broad spectrum of individuals. This collection, which is intuitively woven into several different core vocabulary sets and phrase-based sets, incorporates the AAC vocabulary research of Dr. David Beukelman, Dr. Diane Bryen and Barbara Collier.

myCore

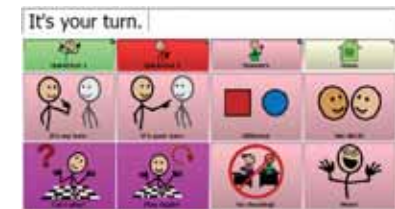
myCore is a combination of core and phrase based vocabulary geared toward individuals with literacy skills. myCore is only available for the ALT-Chat.

myQuickChat

myQuickChat is an introductory communication system geared toward child and adult AAC users with complex communication needs. It offers a high frequency, phrase-based communication system in an easy-to-use, yet very engaging format. The progressive system offers a variety of topics for everyday needs and conversation and provides immediate and more successful communication exchanges within a variety of settings. myQuickChat is available for both children and adults in 4, 8 and 12 locations, each with an identical 16 location Support Master Home Page.

VocabPC™

VocabPC was designed by Gail Van Tatenhove, PA, MS, CCC-SLP, for adults and adolescents with developmental disabilities. Vocabulary in VocabPC is arranged as carrier phrases, interactive sentences, activity vocabulary and naming words. VocabPC uses a 12 location page layout. A tour guide for VocabPC is included on the NOVA chat Editor CD. This tour guide describes the users the author was working with and provides rationales and teaching support for VocabPC.

MultiChat 15

Two versions of this 15 location vocabulary were created, one for school-aged individuals with emerging language skills and one for adolescents or adults. There are multiple forms of communication available in this program; sentences, phrases, individual words, recordings for story-telling and visual scenes. Also included are interactive play and reading pages, social pages and a News-2-You starter page for the weekly newspaper's vocabulary. There are symbols on every button with the exclusion of several core words.

4-Basic

Just like it sounds, a basic vocabulary option with 4 buttons per page.

Essence

Essence is specifically designed for adults with acquired speech disorders. The home page contains a spelling keyboard in addition to quick links to pages of commonly used phrases for communication with those you regularly interact with in your family and community. Other pages contain commonly used vocabulary that may be needed for a visit to the doctor, using public transportation, going out to eat, etc. Each page is completely customizable to meet the specific vocabulary needs of each individual.

Spelling

Spelling is a keyboard page set with four word predication buttons and a few pre-stored phrases.

Editor Software

NOVA chat Editor is the Chat software that is able to run on a Windows desktop or laptop computer. Although it can be done on the device, the Editor provides family and/or professionals a way to customize vocabulary for the device user when it is convenient.

Note: Having the vocabulary on a second computer is always recommended as a backup.



Symbol Options for NOVA chat and ChatPC devices

Salttillo Corporation offers two options for symbols in Chat products.

SymbolStix

The default symbol set for NOVA chat, ChatPC-Silk, and ALT-Chat devices is SymbolStix.

SymbolStix is a dynamic symbol set created by N2Y for use in its Internet weekly newspaper, News-2-You, and its online curriculum, Unique Learning System. Generic activities and persons are depicted as lively, vibrant stick figures with "an attitude." (Actual persons incorporated in SymbolStix are drawn as easily recognizable characterizations.) The current suite includes over 4,000 individual drawings/icons.



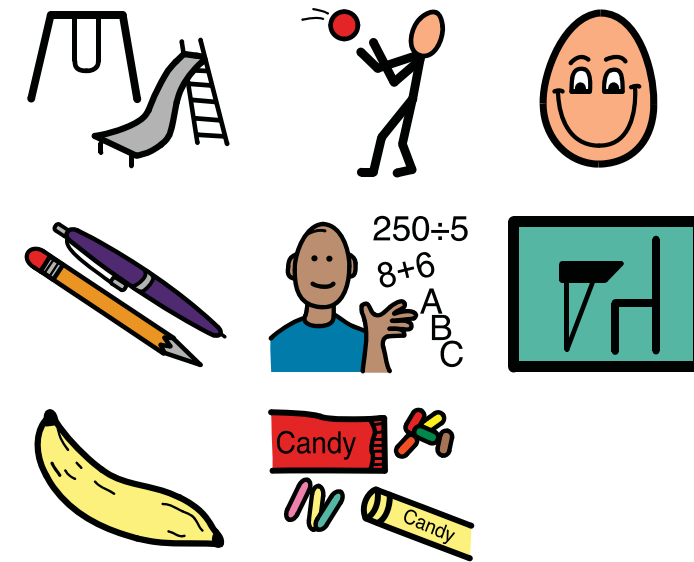
Examples of SymbolStix symbols.

PCS

You can choose PCS symbols in addition to SymbolStix when you order a Chat device. PCS symbols are very popular in classrooms and clinics throughout the world. These symbols have been created by Mayer-Johnson and are used in Mayer-Johnson's BoardMaker and Speaking Dynamically applications. Several thousand symbols represent vocabulary for a wide variety of school, home and work activities. PCS symbols can be selected for Chat devices as a \$375 option.

ChatPC-4™

The ChatPC-4 is a rugged device that is designed to withstand even the most active lifestyle. Integrated within the ChatPC-4 is an industrial PocketPC computer. The unit is further ruggedized by a protective rubber housing, available in blue or black.

The ChatPC-4 has several options for mounting and transport. Inserts on the back accommodate a wheelchair mounting plate. Loops at the bottom of the unit accommodate a carrying strap. The protective screen protector also serves as a convenient stand for the ChatPC-4.

ChatPC-4 includes over 3,000 PCS symbols. An additional 7,000 PCS symbols are included in the accompanying DesktopChat software. Installed vocabulary programs include PalmChat, VocabPC, 16 Primary and 16 Basic.

Ordering and Price Information

When ordering a Chat device there are a few items you will need to consider so that your client or family member receive the most appropriate functionality to meet their needs. Here are the steps to make that happen.

STEP 1:

Choose a model

Chat devices are available in three models. Models differ from each other in features and capabilities as well as in the warranty period. Below is a description of each model.

Standard Model

The standard models are designed for individuals who will primarily be using symbols for communication. Although these models have keyboard pages for spelling, they do not include word prediction or abbreviation-expansion. Standard models come with a one year warranty. Standard models are "open" systems, meaning you can also run other platform specific applications on these devices.

Plus Model

The Plus models are designed for individuals with existing or emerging literacy skills. In addition to all of the features of the Standard models, Plus models come with 10,000, 30,000 and 60,000 word dictionaries. Numerous keyboard pages with and without spelling prediction are included in the pre-stored vocabulary files. Plus models also include abbreviation-expansion, a feature that allows you to encode a word, phrase or sentence under a short sequence of letters. Plus models also provide the capability to load and save text files. Plus models are "open", meaning you can also run other platform specific applications on these devices. Plus models come with a one year warranty.

Dedicated Plus Model

The guidelines for Medicare and for Medicaid in many states require that devices purchased with funds from these organizations are "dedicated" devices. Dedicated devices are devices that can only be used as communication devices, i.e. no other applications can be run on the devices. The Dedicated Plus Chat Models meet the funding requirements of these organizations. Dedicated Plus models include all of the features of the Plus models and come with a three year warranty. Dedicated Plus models also include a carrying case.

STEP 2:

Choose a speech synthesizer

When ordering a NOVA chat 7 or NOVA chat 10 the IVONA speech synthesizer is included. As an option you can add the Acapela speech synthesizer, the voices will be added to existing IVONA voice options. The cost to include Acapala voices to NOVA chat is \$95. Below is a description of the NOVA chat synthesizers.

- > IVONA (IVONA) is a leader in the field with natural voice quality and inflection. IVONA voices include a child's voice, teenage voice, 2 adult female US English voices, one adult male US English voice, two adult female British voices and an adult male British English voice option.
- > Acapela (ACAP) voices include Graham: UK Male, Peter: UK Male, Ryan: US Male, Nizareng UK Male, Lucy: UK Female, Heather: US Female, Laura: US Female, Rachel: UK Female, Tracy: US Female, Kenny: US Boy (child), Nelly: US Girl (child).

When ordering a ChatPC or ALT-Chat, you need to specify a speech synthesizer. Below is a description of each synthesizer and its device availability.

- > Loquendo (LOQ) has 2 adult voices in US English, UK English, French, German, Italian and Spanish. Loquendo is an available option for ChatPC-Silk.
- > NeoSpeech (NEO) is the most natural sounding voice. NeoSpeech has 2 adult voices (male and female) in US English. NeoSpeech is an available option for ChatPC-Silk and ALT-Chat.
- > Acapela (ACAP) is available in English-Spanish or English-German variations. English voices include both adult and child voices. Acapela is an available option for ChatPC-Silk and ALT-Chat.

STEP 3:

Specify Symbol Sets

By default, all Chat devices include SymbolStix symbols. PCS symbols can be specified by adding PCS to the end of the device model number and adding \$375 to the device price. For example ALT-NEO-BLU-PCS specifies PCS symbols for an ALT-Chat. See page 11 for a description of both symbol sets.

STEP 4:

Specify Bilingual devices

NOVA chat 7 & 10 are only available in English. By default ChatPC-Silk and ALT-Chat have bilingual English-Spanish capabilities. Please note: Acapela or Loquendo speech synthesizers should be specified for devices that will be used as bilingual devices.

STEP 5:

Choose color

NOVA chat devices come with 4 interchangeable color shells, the unit will ship with Gray unless another color is specified on the order. ChatPC-Silk has no color option. ALT-Chat is the only Chat device you need to specify a color, ALT-Chat is available in black, blue, and red.





Ordering and Price Information cont.

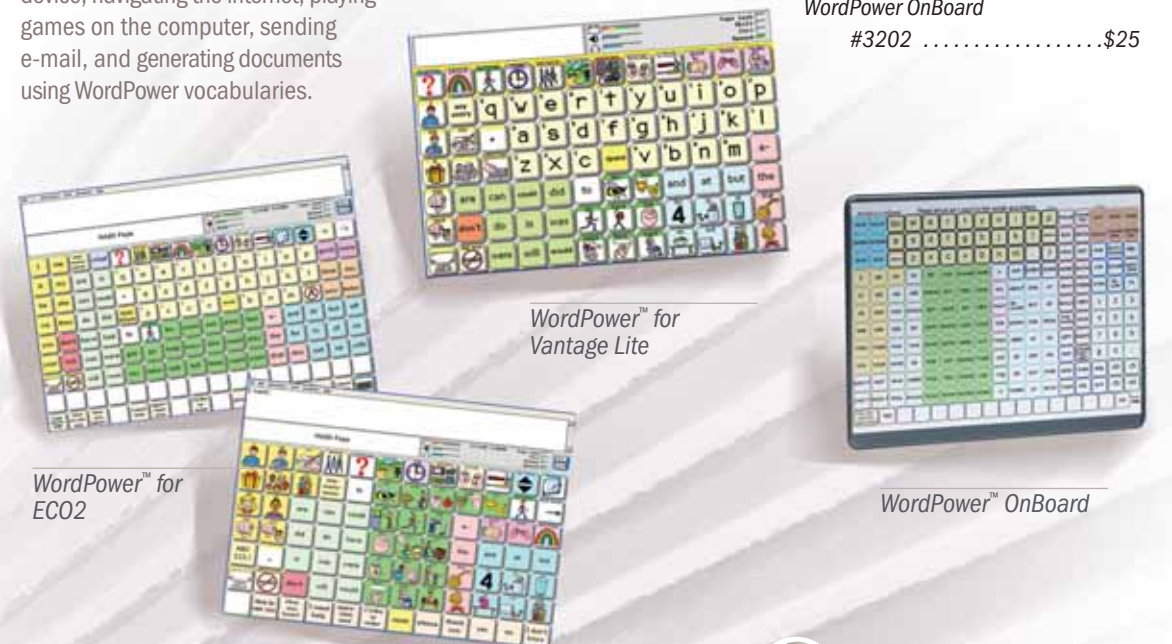
